This gives us immense pleasure to inform you that in support of an initiative of the Government of India to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of Independence and the glorious history of its people, culture and achievements, we are celebrating **Patriotic Week - Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav** in the school. To celebrate the 75th anniversary of Independence, we have planned different activities and competitions to promote nationalism and patriotism among the students.

Schedule for Patriotic week -

- 08 Aug, Mon - Tri Colour Potluck Lunch (IV - VII)** Students need to bring TriColour Lunch and there will be a potluck lunch party in the class.
- 10th Aug, Wed - Poem Recitation Activity (IV)** Students will come prepared with the Poem on the theme of 75 years of Independence for the Poem Recitation Competition. Please note the poem should be on the given theme and students can use the hand props and theme based costume as per the selection of the poem. The best entries will be rewarded.
- 10th Aug, Wed - Slogan Making Competition (V)** Students will come prepared with the Slogan and they need to present their slogans creatively on a chart paper.
Please note that the students need to bring any type of colours as per their choice. A4 sized sheets will be provided by the school. The best entries will be rewarded.
- 10th Aug, Wed - Sash Decoration Competition (VI)** The Tricolour sash will be provided to the students and they have to decorate them using colours and any embellishments which they can bring from home. The best entries will be rewarded.
- 10th Aug, Wed - Tri Colour Rangoli Making (VII)** It will be a group competition where the students will make the Rangoli design using Tri colours (Orange, White, and Green only). Students need to bring the Rangoli colours (only Tri colours) from home. Please note that the National Flag is not to be made with the Rangoli.
- 13 Aug, Sat - Topic Talk - 75 years of Independence and Open Mic (IV - VII)** There will be a discussion in the class where the teachers will remind the students about the struggle of our freedom fighters, the journey of independence and independent India. Students can share their views by presenting any acts, poem, speech or a song after the discussion.
- 13 Aug, Sat - Jamming Session - Patriotic Songs (IV - VII)** All the students with the teachers will have the Jamming session of the patriotic songs in their classes and will wish each other Happy Independence Day.
